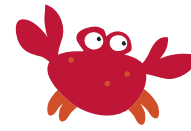

After careful planning and discussions with our Nipper Camp Leaders, we have finalised the details of our trial fortnight of **Nippers Camp 2021**.

## WHO IS NIPPER CAMP FOR?

*Nipper Camp is for children who are School Nursery Age (starting reception in September) and any children who are not 5 at the time of the camp.*

## WHEN WILL IT RUN?

*Monday 26th July through to Friday 6th August.*

## HOW LONG WILL IT RUN FOR?

*The Nipper Camp will run from 09.30-12.30 with the option to book into our Breakfast Club which starts at 08.30.*

## WHAT WILL YOUR CLUBBER BE DOING?

*Your child will be participating in age appropriate Sporting Activities and Arts&Crafts activities too!*

## WHO WILL BE RUNNING IT?

*Your child's health and safety is the most important thing to us. That's why I have taken on the best team for the job. Our team is made up of Senior Leaders in schools and highly skilled and qualified Early Years Practitioners who work in schools everyday. Only the best Staff Team will do for our little Nippers. You can expect the same level of professionalism you'd expect from a school - this is something I have tried to emulate in the main camp and feel like we have been really successful at gaining and keeping our parents trust.*

## HOW MUCH WILL IT COST?

*£15 per day plus £5 if your child attends our breakfast club.*

## HOW MANY NIPPERS CAN ATTEND?

*24 spaces per day is our capacity this year.*

## WHY ISN'T IT RUNNING ALONGSIDE THE MAIN CAMP AND WHY FOR JUST 4 HOURS MAXIMUM?

*I would love to have run this Nippers trial for more day's and have created longer sessions for them. Having read the guidance from the Department for Education around holiday provision it states that holiday clubs cannot host children under 5 years old for more than four hours per day.*

*We aim to be Ofsted Registered in the next 18 months which would bring us more flexibility on this. But for now, the rules are the rules and this is how it has to be.*

*I understand that lots of nursery children (and the youngest reception children) will be doing full days at school. My own nursery aged daughter manages full days at nursery, but it's important to note that we are not a nursery so have to play by different rules.*
